


ACCESS YOUR MWU STUDENT EMAIL ACCOUNT

Learn how to access your MWU Student Email Account.

Midwestern University student email accounts are created 24 hours AFTER your matriculation has been paid. If you have not made this payment, then you will not be able to access your email in addition to other online resources within the MWU Student portal.

GET STARTED


- 1. Log into MWUNet to access your student account by visiting: https://online.midwestern.edu.
- 2. On the student MWUNet main dashboard you will see a series of organized links.
- 3. Locate Resources and click the MWU Office 365 link (MWU Office 365).
 - This link will take you to the Microsoft Login page for ALL Microsoft applications including Word, PowerPoint, Excel, Outlook (email).
 - If you would like to access your MWU Microsoft account without having to log into the student portal first, you can also go to https://portal.office.com




4. Clicking the MWU Office 365 link (MWU Office 365) will take you to a Microsoft login screen. Enter in your MWU email address (StudentPortalName@midwestern.edu) and click the Next button.


IMPORTANT: This will be the username you log into your **MWU student portal** with followed by @midwestern.edu.

5. Enter your password once redirected to the **Enter Password** window. Use the same password you use to log into your **MWU Student Portal Account** and click the **Sign In** button.





- 6. Select YES or NO when prompted if you want to Stay Signed in?
- **7.** If successfully logged into your **MWU Microsoft account** you will see a list of all available **Microsoft** applications along the left-hand side.
- 8. To access your MWU Student Email Account click the Outlook icon ()
